

DIFFERENTIATING TEACHING ACCORDING TO INDIVIDUAL LEARNING STYLE: OPTIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

ABSTRACT

Learning styles vary across individuals. There are more than 71 learning styles that have been identified along at least twenty different dimensions.
